This role entails relief Refuge / Project Worker cover for the Accommodation, Helpline and Drop-in services. Minimum a level 7 degree in Applied Social Studies in Social Care. The appointee must hold a recognised qualification and have eligibility to register as a Social Care Worker according to CORU registration requirements November 2025.

- To treat individuals availing of our service with respect and dignity.
- To contribute in a respectful and positive way to the persons wellbeing and development. To be aware of the authentic needs of each person being supported.

- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written and the ability to work effectively with in a team.
- Flexibility with regard to working hours is essential. Experience of working or volunteering in a Social Care Setting would be a distinct advantage. A full driving licence is desirable.
