Location of Post: The post holder will be located in Petersburg Outdoor Education and Training Centre, Clonbur, Co. Galway. Successful post holder(s) may be transferred within the organisation to allow for the allocation of additional duties, as and when required, which may include the reassignment to other duties where necessary.

Hours of Work: 35 hours per week. Attendance will be required during normal ETB office hours and at such other times as are necessary for the delivery of the duties of the post.
