We are currently seeking a 15 hour per week Support Worker to join the Réidh team. This role will involve supporting participants, who are 16- 30 year old International Protection Applicants and Refugees in their group volunteering initiatives and leading social integration activities, including Community Connect—our Thursday evening social club—as well as other community engagement and social events designed to build connections and reduce isolation.

These roles offer **unique opportunities** to work directly with young people, creating inclusive, empowering environments where they feel heard, supported, and inspired. These roles are ideally suited to dynamic, trauma-informed professionals who want to be part of something new and impactful in growing communities.
