'Programme Manager - Policy and Engagement'

The Programme Manager - Policy and Engagement is a senior post within AIIHPC supporting the AIIHPC CEO to advance AIIHPC's key strategic role within the hospice and palliative care environment across the two jurisdictions (Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland) in line with AIIHPC's aims of ensuring excellent palliative care is available for everyone at the right time and place across the island of Ireland. The Programme Manager of Policy and Engagement supports AIIHPC's member organisations and key stakeholders in engaging with policy developments and leading on engaging with key audiences including members of the public. The role leads on ensuring meaningful engagement with AIIHPC's Voices4Care Volunteer Group, AIIHPC's annual raising awareness campaign of palliative care, 'Palliative Care Week' and leads on the Community of Practice for Specialist Palliative Care Volunteer Managers.

The post is 1.0 WTE Specified Purpose Contract for one year with a salary of €59,672 - €72,373 per annum. Salary is calculated based on level of experience.
