We also engage in the provision of services to charities, including the authorising of appointments of new charitable trustees, the framing of schemes of incorporation, authorisation of Cy-Près schemes and disposition of lands held upon charitable trusts.

Under [Part 4 of the Charities Act 2009 \(http://www.irishstatutebook.ie/eli/2009/act/6/section/64/enacted/en/html#part4\)](http://www.irishstatutebook.ie/eli/2009/act/6/section/64/enacted/en/html#part4) the Charities Regulator has the power to appoint investigators to investigate the affairs of any charitable organisation.
