To this end Kilkenny LEADER Partnership in collaboration with the Town Team and the Local Enterprise Office are seeking to recruit a Development Worker.

The focus of this role will be:

- Supporting the upgrade and development of the community hall as a resource for the local community.
- Support the opening and development of business plan for the Remote Working Hub in the town.
- Working with community groups, Kilkenny County Council, and other parties to explore sectoral /cluster alongside economic opportunities for the area.
- Improve outdoor facilities, explore walkability, leisure spaces and town trails.
- Work with partners such as Kilkenny Co Co to ensure the local infrastructure is fit for purpose.
- Support gathering of key partners around improvement of broadband in the town.
- Linking town to ecological, social, and economic opportunities attached to re-wetting of bogs in the region and other natural and heritage resources in the town and its hinterland.
- Support the development of broad community connection to these activities using community development processes.
- Delivering the development and delivery of community events that support the building of civic pride.
