### **FAIM Project Worker (F/T)**

**In Sync** Youth & Family Services (formerly Kildare Youth Services) supports young people, children and families in Co. Kildare & West Wicklow to enable them to live a full and active life within their communities and society.

The FAIM Project (Family Assessment & Intervention Model) is a differential response type model. It is an initiative developed by **In Sync** Youth & Family Services and Tusla, the Child and Family Agency in Kildare/West Wicklow. It aims to ensure child welfare concerns are addressed as quickly as possible and to provide children and families with an assessment of need and a brief intervention based on their needs. We are now recruiting a Project Worker to join this experienced team.

The successful candidate must demonstrate that they have:

- A recognised third level qualification in one of the following:
  - Social Work
  - Social Care
  - Youth / Community Work
  - Early Childhood Care & Education
  - Education
  - or a related discipline e.g. Nursing, Psychology, and Early Years Education etc.
- A minimum of 3 years' experience of working with young people, children and families in a paid capacity.
- Experience of formally assessing the needs of children and families who are at risk.
- Experience of planning and implementing brief interventions/supports in partnership with children and families.
- Experience of preparing clear needs-led reports on children and families.
- A working knowledge of Children First and of the Children Act 2001 (Revised March 2013).

**In Sync** Youth & Family Services will employ the successful candidate on a 12 month fixed-term contract renewable depending on funding, including a 6 month probationary period.

**In Sync** is an organisation that supports employees in a variety of ways i.e. family friendly policies, flexible working arrangements, blended working; generous annual leave allowance; paid maternity leave; internal support & supervision; pension contributions (post-probation) and, support for continuous professional development etc.
