- To provide one-to-one counselling and support for clients of the service.
- To provide telephone/online counselling and support for clients of the service and for relatives or friends impacted by Sexual Abuse.
- To maintain up to date records of all counselling sessions on the services database.
- To keep notes and data in line with Kilkenny Rape Crisis Centre's policy.
- Liaise and consult with other professionals and agencies where required.
- To observe strict confidentiality in respect of all clients of the service.
- To work as part of a whole team approach.

- To maintain supervision in line with best practice and Kilkenny Rape Crisis Centre's policy.
- To participate in public awareness campaigns as appropriate.
- Any other reasonable duty as requested by the Manager.
