

Counselling Psychotherapist (Panel of Specialists) for Liffey Partnership - The Person

Liffey Area Partnership CLG is seeking to appoint to our panel of specialists a person with a passion for working with people impacted by marginalisation and disadvantage supporting them to improve their mental health and quality of life through the therapeutic process. The position is available on a self-employed basis with a guarantee of minimum 7 hours per week paid at €60 per hour.

The Counselling Psychotherapist will work with clients from a wide range of target groups (including people impacted by poverty, unemployment and/or educational disadvantage, members of ethnic minorities, people parenting alone, people with disabilities or chronic illness) to provide counselling and support to clients affected by a wide range of presenting issues including anxiety and low mood, complex family and personal situations and the impact of marginalisation. Counselling forms part of the work of the Health and Inclusion team and will be delivered in a secure environment from our Dublin 10 office. Facilities available include a reception area and dedicated counselling room. Clients of the counselling service engage in a range of wrap-around supports in terms of employment, education, family support, community engagement and health promotion relevant to their needs and circumstances.

The successful candidate will be accredited as a counsellor with the Irish Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (IACP) / ICP; or a relevant body within the Irish Council for Psychotherapy. They will have a minimum of 2 years' experience of working in a therapeutic setting that included working with clients experiencing marginalisation and disadvantage.
