Duties & Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing community based individual sessions to children referred to the service. • Carry out initial assessment to ensure suitability to service. • Work collaboratively with the child / young person and family to carefully consider the aims of therapy interventions and to continually review work. • Assess the needs of the children and develop tailored therapeutic plans. • Utilise a variety of play therapy techniques to address emotional, psychological, and behavioural issues. • Work in partnership with the Clinical Lead and the therapeutic services team to ensure efficient and timely delivery of the play therapy service. • Maintain accurate and confidential records of all therapy sessions and client interactions. • Develop and implement treatment plans based on initial assessments and ongoing evaluations. • Monitor and evaluate the progress of each child, adjusting therapeutic approaches as needed. • To work in line with the Policies and Procedures of Bagenalstown FRC. • To fulfil obligations as per the Children First Act 2015 and comply with Bagenalstown FRC Child Protection policy. • To comply with responsibilities under the Data Protection Acts 1988, 2003 & 2018 (GDPR).
